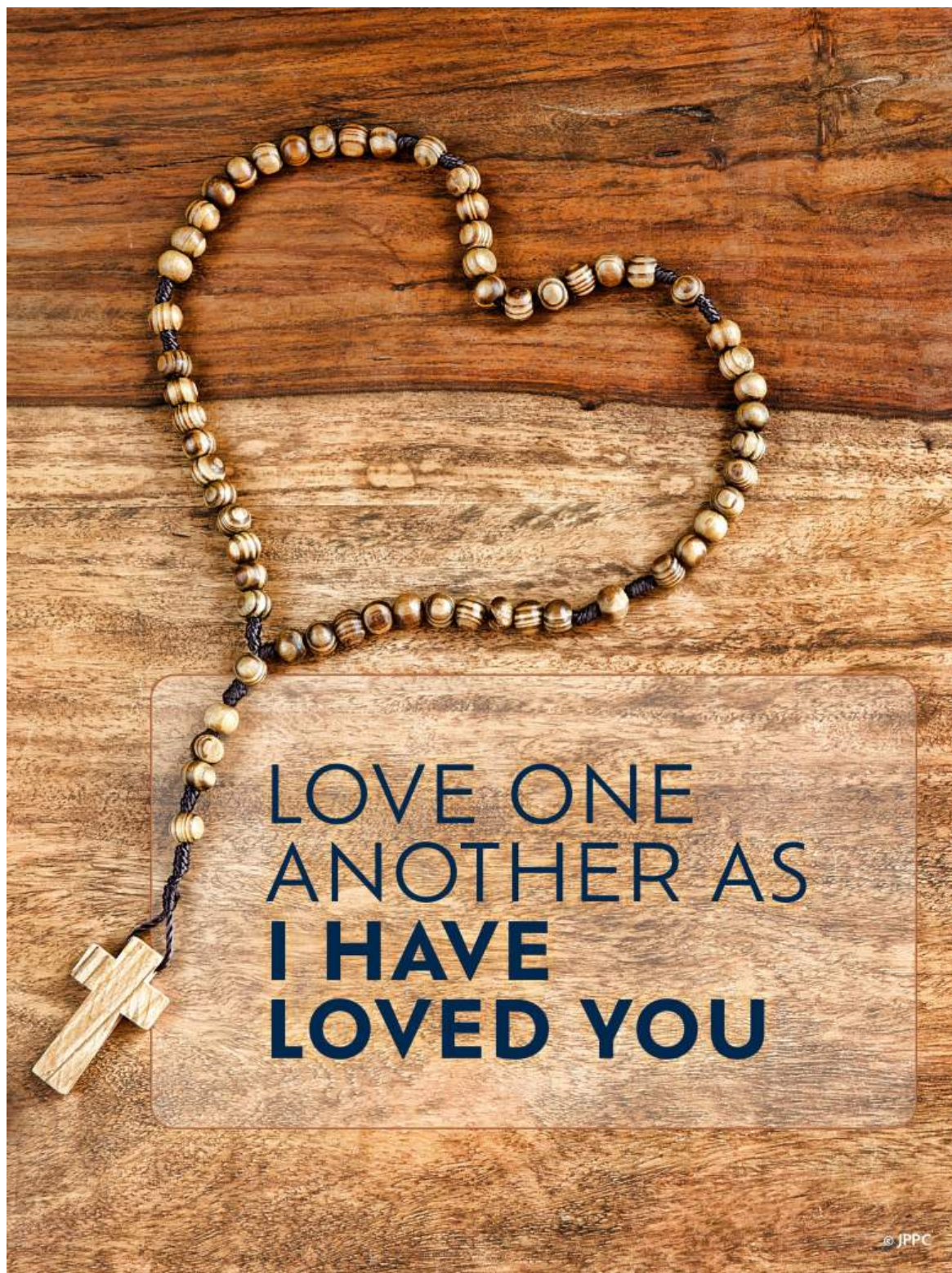

Dear Friends,

We continue to celebrate the Easter Season today, glorying in the resurrection of our Lord, who has promised to remain with us always. Jesus is with us in our waking and sleeping, in our joys and our sufferings, in our homes and our communities. In a special way the risen Lord was with us today as we gathered in faith, in the ministers of the Mass and in each other, in God's Word proclaimed and, in the Body and Blood of Jesus, we received. Once more, let us commit ourselves to becoming missionary disciples, bringing the Lord with us wherever we go and whatever we do, and to whomever we meet, striving always to be messengers of the joy of the Resurrection!

This Monday we will have extended Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament with a simple reposition at 7PM in the chapel. Please come and spend some time after the workday to give praise and thanks to God for his many blessings.

This Wednesday is our annual Parish May Procession. We will assemble in church at 7PM for a Liturgy of the Word and homily given by Father Ryan Nguyen, the parochial vicar of Saint Bede the Venerable in Holland, followed by a rosary procession to the prayer garden for the Litany to the Blessed Mother and final blessing. The entire devotion is no more than one hour, but what an hour it is, honoring our Blessed Mother and asking her intercession for peace in the world, our Church, and our families. I assure you it will be an hour well spent!

The nomination process is now closed for membership on the Parish Pastoral Council. I am grateful to those who were willing to place their names in nomination. We have three openings on the council. In next week's bulletin, we will have a picture and a brief curriculum vitae for each nominee. You will be invited to vote for the new members on the weekend of May 18/19.

Saint Joseph/Saint Robert School is hosting their annual 5K RACE for Catholic Education. The children's run begins at 6PM followed by the adult run. It is a great night of fun for the whole family. I think he won for his category, which I believe was the "Priest Category." He runs for the spirit of all priests!

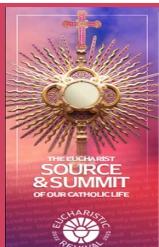
This Saturday, May 11th, at the Basilica of Saints Peter and Paul, Archbishop Perez will ordain six men to the Transitional Diaconate for the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. God willing, these men will be ordained priests next May. Please keep them in your prayers as they make this commitment in their journey to the priesthood and serve as Deacons throughout the archdiocese this year. As of this writing, I was told by the seminary administration that we will be getting a Transitional Deacon from another diocese to be with us beginning in September. I was not told who is coming, but could it be another deacon from Lincoln? We will have to wait and see!

Next weekend is Mother's Day. We will be offering all the Masses for all mothers, especially the names of the mothers listed on our remembrance envelopes. These names will remain in the sanctuary for the month of May and will be included in our daily prayers.

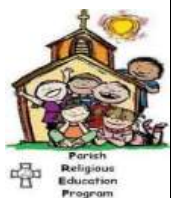

PREP PROGRAMS for 2024-2025:

We offer 2 options for our Parish Religious Education Program for children in Grades 1 - 6. We offer a Summer Confirmation Preparation Camp for our 7th Graders



- ◇ **Our Summer PREP** will be offered the week of June 17th from 8:30 AM to 12:30 PM. (times may change if Central Bucks amends their yearly calendar).
- ◇ **Our Family PREP** will take place on the 1st Sunday of each month from September through April.
- ◇ **Our Confirmation Preparation Camp** will take place the week of June 17th from 8:30 AM until 12:00. (times may change if Central Bucks amends their yearly calendar)

Please check our parish website for a full description of each program.

REGISTRATION AND TUITION INFORMATION:

Summer PREP and Confirmation Preparation Camp registration will run from March 15th through May 1st. If you register by April 20th, you will receive the regular tuition fees. After April 20th, a late fee will be assessed per family.

Family PREP registration will run from March 15th through June 15th. If you register by May 5th, you will receive the regular tuition fees. After May 5th, a late fee will be assessed per family.

Current PREP Families

If you're a returning family, please do not fill out a form. You will receive an email from Parish Giving on the morning that registration opens on March 15th at approximately 9:30 AM. This email will contain login credentials for a Parish Giving account that was created for you. There is no need for you to create a Parish Giving account. If registration opens, and you don't receive this automated email, please contact our office 215-343-9433.

New Families and Incoming 1st Grade Registration

To register for PREP classes, you need to be a registered member of St. Robert Bellarmine Parish. Please go to our Parish website saintrobertwarrington.org and click on the **PREP** tab. Go to the **Registration and Tuition** page to locate the new family form. Click on the link for either Summer PREP or Family PREP. Once you complete this form, the Religious Education office will be notified and will review your application. If approved, you will receive an automated email from Parish Giving with login credentials for an account that was created for you. Sign into your account to make a payment and select sessions for your child/ren.

The Deaf Apostolate serves over 900 families with deaf members across the Archdiocese of Philadelphia. The Deaf Apostolate provides pastoral care, sacramental preparation, religious education, and a regular schedule of Masses in ASL for the Catholic community who are deaf or hard of hearing. SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

First Sunday of the month at 12:15 pm. Baptism Classes for parents and godparents are held on an announced day in January, March, May, July, September and November at 7 pm in the Church. Call the parish office to pre-register.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

You must be a registered member of the Parish and must notify the priest at **least six months** prior to your marriage date. 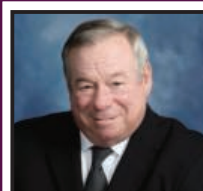

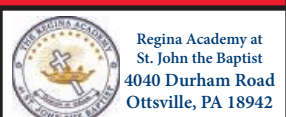
